I would like to take the present opunity to invite you to join us for the 14th Japan-Korea International Symposium on Microbiology (JKISM 2018) that will be held in Fukuoka, Japan in March 2018.

The JKISMs have been held biann**u**ally. Following the successful 13^{th} meeting held in Gyeongbuk, Korea in 2016, the organizing committee is pleased to announce that the 14^{th} JKISM will take place as a joint meeting with the 91^{st} annual meeting of the Japanese Society for Bacteriology (JSB 2018) during March 27^{th} (Tue) – 29^{th} (Thu), 2018 at the Fukuoka international convention center, Fukuoka, Japan. This is the first time to organize JKISM as a joint meeting with the JSB annual meeting. The aims of this challenge are to provide microbiologists in both countries with more opportunities to make scientific and social communications and to discuss about any possibilities of research collaboration.

In this joint meeting, one 2.5-hrs session and two 2-hrs sessions will be specifically dedicated to the JKISM. The former focuses on Mycobacterial infections and invited speakers from both counties will present their recent data on this important topic. To the 2-hrs sessions which were planned to facilitate the communications/interactions of young researchers of both countries, young researches actively working in various fields of microbiology have been invited from the two countries.

In addition to these programs, we would like to offer opportunities of poster presentation to Korean researches working on any bacteria and fungi, their infections, and anti-microbial host defense. As registration fees will be waived for all Korean participants who will make poster presentations and we will cover their accommodation fees (up to 3 nights), we strongly encourage young Korean researchers to take this opportunity to share experience and forge new friendships with Japanese researchers. Several international sessions planed for JSB 2018 will also provide you invaluable opportunities to acquire many pieces of new information. In addition, I would like to emphasize that Fukuoka is the largest city on the Kyushu Island and represents the main gateway to Japan from Korea and one of the best places where you can fully enjoy Japanese foods.

I am very looking forward to welcoming and hosting you in Fukuoka in March 2018, and sincerely hope that you will join us to make this endeavor a success.

2. Presentation Method



Poster number is on the upper left of each panel prepared by the secretariat. Tacks will be prepared at each presentation panel by the meeting secretariat.

- Please indicate your presentation title, affiliation(s), author(s) on the right side of the poster number within the size of 65cm wide x 25cm high. Please put ".o". before the name of presenter.
- The poster title should be written large enough to be read 5m away. We recommend you to use the font size bigger than 36-point. The poster text should be written large enough to be read 3m away.

We recommend you to use the font size bigger than 18-point.
